

### WEB ARCHIVING IN THE NATIONAL LIBRARY

The Hungarian National Széchényi Library (NSZL) – as national libraries in many countries – has a responsibility for long term preservation of publicly available internet resources, especially websites. By the development framework of the National Library Platform a pilot project has started in spring 2017 in order to establish the professional conditions of a Hungarian web archive.

#### WHY?

the Hungarian web should have a past, not just a present

the history of the virtual world must be researchable, the online imprints of the current events in the real world must be preserved

the large volume of digital information must be analyzable and visualizable

there is a need for stable references to online sources in education materials and scientific publications

### WHAT?

mainly Hungarian websites focusing on culture, science, education or public events

Hungarian electronic periodicals: journals, magazines, news sites and blogs

relevant contents related to Hungary on foreign webservers

publicly available social networking sites of important Hungarian institutions and persons

#### HOW?

thematic collections by topic, genre or institution have crawled periodically

in some cases written copyright agreements are requested from the content owners to publish the archived copies publicly

temporal harvests of webpages related important national or world-wide events

representative crawls of the Hungarian websphere once or twice a year

software background: Heritrix, Web Curator Tool, HTTrack, ArchiveWeb.page, Brozzler, PyWb, OpenWayback, SolrWayback...

number of selected websites ca. 75,000, total size of the archive: 85 TB

the public collection contains 335 websites, periodicals or blogs, and 99 online content services of the national library
